Success Stations are a great tool for teaching humans and the skills needed to teach behaviors clearly.

The Success Station ensures that human behavior is consistent, a requirement for efficient learning.

Our dog's learn best when skills are broken down into their component behaviors and each small skill taught before combining to make the "big picture" behavior "chain".

The station is designed to be updated as soon as the dog is able to perform a step. Each step is combined with the previously learned step, so by the end of the skills list your dog has learned how to do all the little behaviors that lead up to the Big Goal.
